

PATIENT BILL OF RIGHTS

The following is a list of your patient rights as a patient of Carlisle Place Physical Therapy and Wellness Center, LLC

YOU HAVE A RIGHT TO:

- Be treated with respect, consideration, and dignity regardless of psychosocial, spiritual and/or cultural values. Patients will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin, disability, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and religion and creed.
- To be fully informed by a physician and or therapist of his/her medical condition related to therapy services in terms that can be reasonably understood, unless contraindicated.
- To obtain necessary information from the therapist to be able to give consent to the treatment plan.
- Not feel deprived of any rights guaranteed by law based solely on his/her status as a patient.
- Be provided physical access to the facility for physical and visual impaired.
- To obtain the name and function of any person providing services to you.
- To be provided privacy and safety during your care.
- To be permitted access if needed to any clinical notes and records.
- To expect that all information gathered during treatment, disclosures and records be treated confidentially, except when required by law, and to be given the opportunity to approve or refuse the release.
- To be informed to the extent to which charges will or will not be covered by insurance (as seen in explanation of benefits provided as a courtesy to you).
- Obtain a detailed explanation of your bill when requested.
